UNIFORM FOR SEPTEMBER 2018

Just another reminder about the changes proposed to the main school uniform and PE kit for September 2018. Zutti will start selling this from the start of the summer holidays.

We will be retaining the black blazer colour but it will have a new badge showing a new symbol and Co-op Academy Failsworth. If we need to support any individual parents there will be an option to supply a 'new pocket' for old blazers with the new symbol and name on. We will also be retaining the black pleated skirt and black trouser option. We will not insist on new skirts for students with the old Failsworth School logo on the waistband from September 2018, but as you replace it will only be new stock available. (The new skirt is a plain black pleated style).

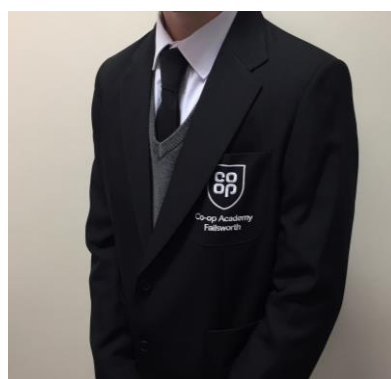
Finally, the main uniform change is to be a grey jumper and school tie. The symbol and academy name will be embroidered on the jumper, and the tie is a new design. These will replace the burgundy jumper and current tie from September 2018. If students outgrow their current jumper in the final half term (June/July 2018) we will allow them not to wear a jumper in readiness for the new grey jumper in September. We often do this in the warmest half term of the year. If parents have an issue with a jumper between Easter and Whit half term please contact us and we will try and help, as replacing the burgundy jumper for 6 weeks is not appropriate.

We also intend to change the PE kit for September 2018. This will see a new, more modern and comfortable option. The current Year 7 wear a blue version of this already and will continue to wear this until natural replacement beyond September 2018 where they will then follow the whole school change (in September 2018) to black T-shirt and black shorts, (leggings and black T-shirt for Year 9, 10, 11 dancers), and black socks. Other optional items of PE kit, such as tracksuits, will also be available to purchase from September 2018.

The governors and myself are very aware that uniform is an additional expense and we are trying to give as much notice as possible - over 2 terms, plus 2 options above - to reduce the cost.

Zutti in Oldham will remain our uniform supplier. They supply most schools/academies in Oldham. They will supply the blazer, jumper, tie and PE kit. They will also offer the skirt and trousers to parents who wish to purchase them. In addition, Zutti offer a free alteration service. Zutti are a long serving uniform supplier who use ethical sources and provide high quality products at a reasonable cost. We have checked the price against other schools/academies in Oldham and are confident that it presents value for money.

THE SCHOOL DAY FOR THE CURRENT YEAR 10 WHO GO INTO YEAR 11 IN SEPTEMBER

A second reminder (following my letter in January 2018) that the school day will be longer next year for the new Year 11. They will be following our current Year 11 this year, by having an extra lesson on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. This will be known as Period 6 and will run until 3.45pm. and is compulsory.

Year 11 students will receive timetabled small group tuition, which will be set for each 8-10 week block, reviewed, and changed as necessary. This will not be just an extra lesson. It is aimed at targeting areas that need support and improvement. Additionally, periodically we may identify some Year 11 students for support with study skills, revision planning and other bespoke areas outside of normal subjects offered.
